Monday, January 22 nd	Let’s Hunt For a Good Book! Everyone dress in camo today and celebrate the joy of finding a new book to read. Teachers will read their favorite book today and share why it is their favorite!
Tuesday, January 23 rd	Read My Shirt Day! We will promote Literacy today by wearing words on our shirts for everyone to read throughout the day! (school appropriate wording)
